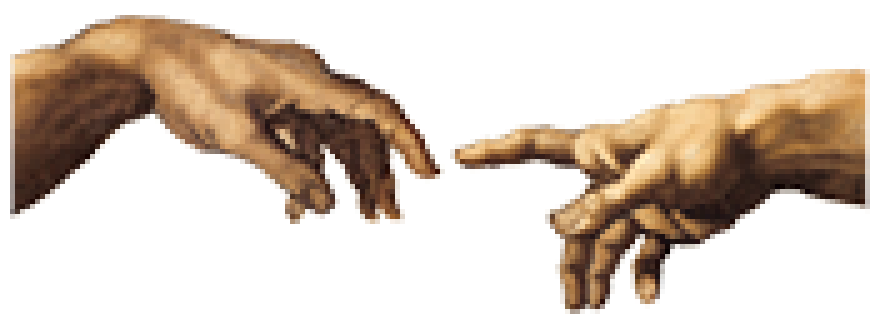

## From Sept 2020 - July 2021

Courses will start entirely online in September. Public health and gallery conditions permitting, it is envisaged that some students will be based at the Wallace Collection, London WC2, with others at the National Gallery, London W1, as in previous years, and some students will remain online.

- Additional EPQ qualification (half an A level in UCAS points)
- Option to continue to study a further two modules in a second year and sit the A level Art History exam
- Access to Careers seminars and Work Experience, past placements include V&A, Royal Collection, Scala Publishers, Art UK, HENI Talks + more
- EPQ/homework support, plus EPQ and careers mentoring, and alumni network membership
